

Zone 1: Within the Rail - Any open space between the perimeters of the rail can present a risk of head entrapment. The FDA recommended space is less than 4.75in (12cm).

Zone 2: Under the Rail - The gap under the rail between the mattress, may allow for dangerous head entrapment. The FDA recommended space is less than 4.75in (12cm).

Zone 3: Between the Rail and the Mattress - This area is the space between the inside surface of the bed rail and the mattress, and if too big it can cause a risk of head entrapment. The FDA recommended space is less than 4.75in (12cm).

Zone 4: Under the Rail at the Ends of the Rail - A gap between the mattress and the lowermost portion of the rail poses a risk of neck entrapment. The FDA recommended space is less than 2.375in (6cm). Also, install the bed rail such that the angle at the end of the bed rail relative to the top of a mattress is greater than 60 degrees.

Zone 5: Between Split Bed Rails - When partial length head and split rails are used on the same side of the bed, the space between the rails may present a risk of head, neck, or chest entrapment.

Zone 6: Between the End of the Rail and the Side Edge of the Head or Foot Board - A gap of less than 12.5in (32cm) between the end of the bed rail and the side edge of the headboard or footboard can present the risk of entrapment of the head, neck, or chest.

Zone 7: Between the Head or Foot Board and the End of the Mattress - When there is too large of a space between the inside surface of the headboard or footboard and the end of the mattress, the risk of head entrapment increases.

The Bed Rail Safety Guard is designed to minimize the risk of entrapment. If you are unsure, we recommend you install the safety guard.




<u>Product Position:</u> Install the product as shown on Figure A, keeping the product at least 12.5 inches from the head and foot plane of the bed. This is required to prevent potential entrapment hazards.

Top of Bed Rail must be a minimum of 4in (102cm) above top surface of mattress as shown in Figure A.

Safety Strap and Other Securing Means: The bed rail must be secured and maintained as close to the mattress as possible as depicted in Figure B. When properly installed there is no gap between the bedrail and the mattress.

<u>WARNING:</u> If the safety strap provided is not properly secured, the product may move into an unsafe position which increases the danger of entrapment. See enclosed ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS for proper use of the straps.

<u>Mattress Thickness</u>: You must measure your mattress and confirm that it is between 10in-12 inch thick. Using a mattress that does not fall within this thickness range increases the risk of entrapment and injury/death.





2. Decide on configuration: Adjustable OR Standard bed frame. See FIGURE 2



3. Remove safety straps from Legs **A** and **B** using tools provided (**G** and **H**). Remove red grippers from both legs using a standard screwdriver as shown in *FIGURE* 3.




- **4.** Partially thread Bolt **L** into lower holes in **C**. Do not thread too far bolt should not block assembly of legs. *FIGURE 4*.
- **4.1.** Lay Main Support **C** on flat surface so markings can be seen. *FIGURE 4.1*.






5. Insert Leg A into C. Align the top edge of C with horizontal line on leg. Align holes on C with the solid vertical line on A, as shown in *FIGURE 5*. Screw Bolt L through hole and tighten firmly with tool H. Insert K into the upper hole and tighten firmly. Repeat for Leg B. Legs should be parallel when assembled.






6. Insert Bolts **M** through Washers **J**, then Main Support **C**, then screw into **D**. Tighten firmly using tool **G** as shown in, *FIGURE 6*.



7. Attach assembly to Back Section or Butt Section of bed base using $\bf N$ – do not overtighten screws. FIGURE 7 IMPORTANT: Installed rail must be at least 12.5" from end of mattress. There should be no gap between $\bf C$ and mattress. NOTE: Make sure screws do not interfere with any components on underside of bed base.




- **8.** Partially thread Bolt **L** into upper holes in **C**. Do not thread too far L should not block assembly of legs. *FIGURE 8*.
- **8.1.** Lay Main Support on flat surface so markings can be seen as in *FIGURE 8.1*.



9. Insert Leg A into C. Align the top edge of C with horizontal line on leg. Align holes on C with the dashed vertical line on A, as shown in *FIGURE 9*. Screw Bolt L through hole and tighten firmly with tool H. Insert K into the lower hole and tighten firmly. Repeat for Leg B. Legs should be at an angle to one another when assembled.



10. Insert Bolts **M** through Washers **J**, then Main Support **C**, then screw into **D**. Tighten firmly using tool **G** as shown in, *FIGURE 10*.



11. Place A and B between Box Spring or Platform and MATTRESS and extend both ends of straps (with buckle ends) below mattress to the opposite side of bed. Unbuckle straps and wrap one end of each around BED FRAME and re-buckle straps. Tighten SAFETY STRAPS F to secure bedrail product against side of the mattress. FIGURE 11. IMPORTANT: Installed rail must be at least 12.5" from head of mattress. There should be no gap between C and mattress. Rail must extend toward foot of bed.


